Re: Annual Permanent Cessation of Coal Combustion Progress Report for Merrimack Station Units 1 and 2 - Flue Gas Desulfurization Wastewater

Dear Mr. Butler:

In accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 423.19(g), this constitutes the “Annual Progress Report” of GSP Merrimack LLC (“GSP” or the “Company”) pertaining to Merrimack Station Units 1 and 2. GSP has elected to comply with the relevant portions of 40 C.F.R. Part 423’s flue gas desulfurization (“FGD”) wastewater provisions relating to “unit[s] that will achieve permanent cessation of coal combustion by December 31, 2028”¹ and currently expects Units 1 and 2 to permanently cease coal combustion by June 1, 2028.

Participants in the permanent cessation category are required to submit an Annual Progress Report.² The Annual Progress Report must discuss interim milestones (including whether any have been completed, missed, or delayed) and also must update these milestones, as needed.³ EPA’s 2024 ELG Rule⁴ also added a new provision that requires a participant to include one of the following in Annual Progress Reports:

- A copy of the official suspension filing (or equivalent filing) made to the facility's reliability authority detailing the conversion to a fuel source other than coal;
- A copy of the official retirement filing (or equivalent filing) made to the facility's reliability authority which must include a waiver of rescission rights; or
- An initial certification, or recertification for subsequent annual progress reports, containing a statement that the facility will make one of the above-referenced filings.⁵

Interim Milestones

GSP does not have any interim milestones or other specific events the Company must complete to achieve the permanent cessation of coal combustion of Units 1 and/or 2 at Merrimack Station by June 1, 2028. Further, GSP does not have any updated milestones to disclose at this time.

Recertification – Reliability Authority Filing

GSP intends to submit an official suspension filing, retirement filing, or equivalent filing to ISO-New England detailing the permanent cessation of coal combustion of Unit 1 and Unit 2 in accordance with the rules and procedures in place in 2027 and/or 2028.
